Open (Government) Data

- Public Data
- Sharable and reusable government can enable informed debate, better decision making, and the development of innovative new services.
- Free use, reuse, and redistribution of government data by anyone.
- Data should be freely available for everyone to access, use, and re-publish as they wish

Others can copy, distribute, display, perform and remix your work if they credit your name as requested by you





No Derivative Works

Others can only copy, distribute, display or perform verbatim copies of your work





Share Alike

Others can distribute your work only under a license identical to the one you have chosen for your work






Non-Commercial

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

- Identity thief
- Financial Fraud
- Invasion of privacy
- Negative impacts to an organization

Handle Personal Data

Tips to Handle Personal Data

- Be aware and pay extra attention when processing personal data
- Keep it safe, delete it, never pass it to other people
- Ask explicitly about how personal data is processed




Privacy-Aware Data Collector

- Data owns by people who it is about
 - Customers data collected by a company (GDPR)
- Data owns by the people who collected it
 - Collected data after removing Personal Identifiers
- Sometimes, the ownership of data is not clear
 - Survey data
